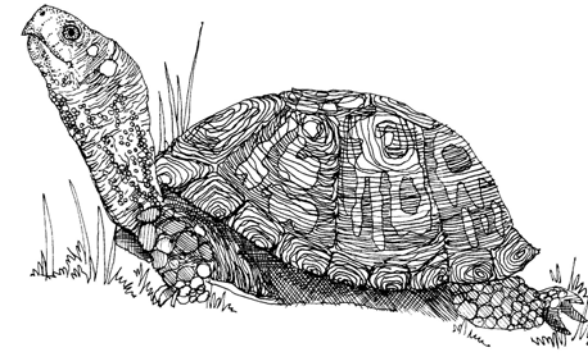


Scout Program
