SUMMER NATURE CAMPS 2007 VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Morning camps: 9:00 a.m. – Noon	Volunteer hours: 8:45 – 12:30
Afternoon camps: 1:00 - 4:00 p.m.	Volunteer hours: 12:45 – 4:30
Full-day camps: 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.	Volunteer hours: 8:45 – 3:30
Extended Camp: 3:00 – 5:30 p.m. 3:00 – 4:00 p.m.	Volunteer hours: (flexible- to be arranged)

NOTE: Volunteers should commit to a full camp. Camps may run for one or two weeks and may be full day, mornings or afternoons only. Volunteers may choose to work with both a morning and an afternoon camp in the same week(s), and may extend their day by helping with the extended camp. All camps begin on a Monday and run for either 5 or 10 days (with the exception that there are **no camps on July 4th**).

DISCOVERY CAMPS AT WOODEND (Pre- K or K in Fall 2007)

The Pre-K and K camps are half-day camps which run for one or two weeks. Volunteers have the option to combine morning and afternoon sessions for a full-day program.
